House Rule Class Rules: Concours D'Elegance will award the turnout which, in the opinion of the judge, presents the most elegant effect. This will include vehicle, harness, appointments, horse(s), driver, passengers, grooms, etc. throughout the competition.



Turnout and Working will run simultaneously and be awarded as 2 separate classes. Turnout will be judged primarily on the quality of the overall turnout. Working will be judged on the suitability of the horse/pony to provide a pleasant drive. Entries to show both ways of the ring at a walk, slow trot, working trot and strong trot. To stand quietly both on the rail and the lineup and to rein back. Entries may be asked to do an individual workout and execute an appropriate test at any gait.

Reinsmanship entries are judged on the ability and skill of the driver at various gaits. Entries will be required to rein back and will be asked to perform an appropriate test.

Timed Cones will be held in the main ring, with numbered cones. The course will be free flowing and designed to highlight the gaits of the animal used as well as the skill set of the driver. This class is also part of the Cones Challenge Division.

Town and Country Obstacles is a timed class similar to timed cones but with the addition of obstacles that may be encountered while driving, such as mailboxes, trashcans, tractors or flag poles. This class is part of the Cones Challenge Division.

Pleasure Drive Pace is a cross country course through numbered gates with an optimum time. There will be elements added to the course to test the ability of the driver and animal.

Safari Drive will be the same course as the Pleasure Drive Pace with the addition of hidden stuffed animals along the route for drivers or passengers to properly identify in correct order and fastest time.
