## **Harness Fit Record**

This chart will help you remember how to put your harness back together after cleaning it, by recording the holes your animal usually uses. It can be a reference to tell you if your animal is changing shape through conditioning, or abundant grazing. If you use a harness on more than one animal it will help you switch it back to fit.
